



iPad Use Agreement 2019

Parent/Guardian Declaration

I understand and agree to the following conditions of my child receiving an iPad:

1. The iPad provided on loan to my child will at all times remain the property of the school and must be returned at any time when requested and when my child ceases to be enrolled at the school.
2. My child will be able to access the internet using the iPad and connecting to any Wi-Fi hotspot or access point whether at school, home or other locations.
3. Whilst the school will take reasonable precautions to prevent access to unsuitable material on the internet through the school Wi-Fi network, it cannot guarantee to prevent or monitor access to unsuitable material at home or any other location.
4. Since the iPad is a school-owned device, students are expected to comply at all times with the terms and conditions of the current school policies which apply to the appropriate use and care of technology. If your child breaches the iPad agreement and in class policies, they will have their iPad confiscated for a duration of time.
5. The iPad will be provided to students with the applications (Apps) installed. Students are not permitted to download additional Apps.
6. In the event that my child's iPad or accessories are lost, stolen, graffiti applied or damaged beyond what would be regarded as 'normal wear and tear', I understand that I will be responsible for the cost of repair or replacement. If the iPad or accessories have to be completely replaced the following maximum charges will apply:
 - iPad : \$ 439
 - iPad Cover : \$ 59
 - iPad Charger : \$ 58
7. Replacement of screen (cracked/chipped): \$139-\$200 extensive screen damage causing damage to hardware: \$439
8. You may be able to include the iPad in your normal home insurance – please check with your insurer.
9. I will encourage my child to meet the requirements of the student declaration, and I will support the school by overseeing the correct use of the iPad.
10. A copy of the condition report, as signed by your child and their class teacher will be kept on file. This copy will be removed once we receive the parent signed report. If the condition report is not returned to your child's PCG teacher within 2 days of your child receiving their iPad we will deem the report on file to be accurate as signed by your child and the class teacher.
11. I acknowledge that I have received and that I have read the iPad Program Information Booklet and the student declaration below.

Student Declaration

I understand and agree to the following conditions of receiving an iPad:

1. I will follow all teacher directions including when to use the iPad.
2. I will provide the iPad to teachers or parents/guardians upon request and give them my Passcode.
3. I will fully charge the iPad the night before each school day.
4. I will ensure my work is placed onto OneDrive to ensure it is secure.
5. I will bring the iPad to school on each school day that I am in attendance.
6. I will seek permission from the teacher and people being photographed or recorded before using the camera and audio recording functions.
7. I will not use the iPad to publish or share photographs, video or audio to any online network unless permission is given by people photographed or recorded and the school.
8. I will not mistreat the iPad or another student's iPad in any way, or apply graffiti of any kind to the iPad, the iPad cover or iPad accessories.
9. I will not lend the iPad to another student or give them the Passcode to the iPad.
10. I will keep the iPad secure and not leave it in such a place that it is likely to be stolen.
11. I will keep the iPad dry and away from rain and water and from food and drink.
12. I will not use the iPad to create or access inappropriate content.
13. I will promptly report any loss, damage or fault with the iPad to the school.
14. I will sign and complete the iPad condition report as soon as I receive my iPad.
15. The library barcode on the back of the iPad is not to be removed from the iPad at anytime.
16. I understand that if I fail to meet these conditions, the iPad may be removed from me for a period of time or even permanently.

The following additional policies and guidelines presented are further required by the Northern Territory Department of Education

1. Viewing, accessing, sending or forwarding material that is of questionable ethics and morality, such as material which is designed to excite sexual desire or material depicting sexual activity.
2. Viewing, accessing, sending or forwarding material which is more than likely to demean or offend employees on the basis of race, ethnicity, gender, or other personal attributes.
3. Viewing, accessing, sending or forwarding material that promotes activity that is illegal in Australia.
4. Communicating harassing, intimidating, offensive, or other material that may give rise to civil or criminal liability.
5. Using ICT services in a manner that will result in personal or financial gain, including the soliciting or selling of personal goods or services.
6. Subscribing to ICT services without approval from the officer who has financial responsibility for the cost incurred.
7. Sending or forwarding SPAM or junk mail, unverified virus alerts, or chain letters; Attempting to modify or remove ICT resources without proper authorisation.
- 8. Attempting to test or defeat any security safeguards established to protect systems and information unless authorised to do so.**
- 9. Bypassing or attempting to bypass assigned resource limits, logon procedures or privileges.**
10. Accessing or using ICT services, including another person's e-mail, Internet or telephone account, or information without proper authorisation.
11. Interfering with the access rights of others, either by technical means or by obtaining access codes or passwords of others.
12. Initiating or being party to any malicious activity directed towards internal or external ICT services.
13. Connecting any privately owned workstation or other network device to the NT Government network without appropriate authorisation.
14. Violating any copyright or software licence agreement.
15. Disclosing or removing third-party proprietary information.

Inappropriate use of school ICT services or deliberate breaches of the conditions of the Student ICT Use agreement may result in access restrictions to ICT facilities for the student(s) involved and result in discipline by school administration.
