## PRIMARY SCHOOL STANDARD TRANSITION TO YEAR 6 SCHOOL UNIFORM

### Boys:

**Formal Uniform** - Royal blue and garnet polo shirt with logo, navy school shorts, black enclosed shoes/runners and white socks. Navy bucket hat.

**Sports Uniform** - House colour PCS polo shirt, navy sports knit shorts with PCS initials, black runners and white socks.

### Girls:

**Formal Uniform** - Royal blue and garnet polo shirt with logo, navy school dress shorts/skorts OR school uniform dress, black enclosed shoes/runners and white socks. Navy bucket hat.

**Sports Uniform** - House colour PCS polo shirt, navy sports knit shorts with PCS initials, black runners and white socks.

## MIDDLE SCHOOL STANDARD YEAR 7-9 SCHOOL UNIFORM

### Boys:

**Formal Uniform** - Navy and white polo shirt with logo, navy school shorts, white socks and black enclosed shoes/runners. Navy cap.

**Sports Uniform** - House colour PCS polo shirt, navy sports knit shorts with PCS initials, white socks and black runners.

### Girls:

**Formal Uniform** - Navy and white polo shirt with logo, navy school dress shorts/skorts, white socks and black enclosed shoes/runners. Navy cap.

**Sports Uniform** - House colour polo shirt, navy sports knit shorts with PCS initials, white socks and black runners.
