YEAR LEVY

Year Levy varies and may include some or all of the following:

FAMILY DISCOUNTS

STUDENT DEPOSIT

A student deposit of **\$150** (primary) and **\$300** (secondary/senior school) per student is payable to the college on acceptance of the student's position. This deposit is recognition of your acceptance of the offer of enrolment and is non-refundable if the student does not commence as anticipated. If the student attends as anticipated, this deposit will be credited to your college fees at the commencement of the school year.

COLLEGE SERVICE LEVY

We actively invite parent participation in their children's education and college community, and many opportunities exist throughout the year to get involved. Volunteering is recorded by parents and carers in the College Service Hours Record book at Front Reception. However, we do understand that not all parents have the time to contribute in person due to work and other commitments, and so the College Service Levy allows those who are unable to take part in person to still contribute in community spirit.

Each family is asked to contribute six hours of college service throughout the year. If this has not been completed by the beginning of Term 4, a **\$210** College Service Levy is placed on your account. If you complete the hours in the final term, the \$210 fee will be removed from your account. Please note that to volunteer at the college you will need a current volunteer ochre card. Ochre card application forms are available at the front office.

TAX DEDUCTIBLE BUILDING FUND DONATION

To help raise funds to continue the building program for the college, we have suggested that families make a donation to the NT Christian Schools Building Fund. These funds are used to repay loans we have for school buildings. The donation is an annual amount. A suggested format is as follows, although you may wish to pay more or less than this.

NOTICE TO WITHDRAW A STUDENT

Parents are required to provide the college with a **full term's notice (10 school weeks)** in *writing* when withdrawing a student from the college. Failure to provide this notice will result in the equivalent of one term's fees being charged in full.
